## ESSER III General Allocation = \$487,641 (20% must address learning loss)

Proposed Expenditures (80% of allocation = \$470,112)

- Music Teacher Salary & Benefits
- Additional Kindergarten Teacher Salary & Benefits
- Tuition Reimbursement for teacher to earn EL Endorsement
- Yearly technology support contract costs
- Replace flooring at GS (2 classrooms) and in HS Cafeteria

Proposed Expenditures (20% of allocation addressing learning loss = \$97,528)

• Paraprofessionals working with IEP students – Salary & Benefits

## ESSER III State Set-Aside Allocation = \$43,029 (Targeted Funding)

Target 1: Additional Learning Loss Funding = \$30,735

- Salary for After-school tutor
- Salary for Summer School Teachers
- Target 2: After-School Programming = \$6,147
  - Staff stipends for after-school programming, interventions, tutoring, etc.
  - Instructional/Intervention supplies

Target 3: Summer School Programming = \$6,147

- Teacher stipends for summer school programming, interventions, tutoring, etc.
- Instructional/Intervention supplies
